

Pool Gate Code Rules

- Pool Gate Codes are provided for access to the pool and pool area
- Pool Gate Codes can only be provided to the property owner; no up-front cost
- Pool Gate Codes are for homeowners or their tenants that live in Meadow Creek Village and their immediate guests
- Only one (1) Pool Gate Code per address is allowed
- Pool Gate Codes may not be shared with any person at an other address within or beyond Meadow Creek Village
- Forgotten codes can be replaced; only provided to the property owner via email*
- Association dues must be current for access to the pool or pool area
- Only five (5) people are allowed entry into pool or pool area for each Pool Gate Code
- Residents must not enter pool area as a guest of another resident of Meadow Creek Village
- **Pool Gate Code Rules** are an attachment to the original **Pool Rules**

Violation of Pool Rules and/or Pool Gate Code Rules will deactivate your code and access to the pool and pool area will no longer be allowed. A new entry code, if provided, must be purchased by the property owner for \$50.

1. There is no lifeguard on duty. Swim at your own risk
2. The pool is reserved for **ADULTS** only (**21+**) from 9am until normal hours
3. Pool Monitors are in charge of the pool & pool area and have the authority to eject rule-breakers and remove codes for entry into the pool & pool area
4. Children **under 13 years of age** **MUST** be accompanied by an adult.
One adult may accompany up to four (4) children.
5. Admittance to pool or pool area is allowed only by using an authorized Pool Gate Code specific to your address. Person authorized to enter pool area must be present at all times for their guests to use the pool.
 - Residents are responsible for the use of their own Pool Gate Code
 - Residents will not be admitted as guests with another resident
 - Maximum of five (5) people allowed into pool or pool area per Pool Gate Code**
6. HOA dues must be current (not delinquent) in order to enter pool or pool area
7. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the pool
8. Profanity, obscene language, threats, or conduct that disturbs other guests at the pool or pool area will result in immediate dismissal from the pool and pool area, and removal of your Pool Gate Code
9. No running, pushing, or fighting is allowed in the pool or pool area
10. No glass containers allowed in the pool or pool area
11. No pets or animals allowed in the pool or pool area other than certified service animals
12. Bicycles, roller blades, skateboards, or similar sports equipment are not allowed in the pool area
13. Swimmers must wear swimwear while in the pool; no jeans, cutoffs, etc. allowed
14. Infants are allowed in the pool provided they wear diapers intended for pool use (swimee's)
Regular diapers are not allowed.
15. Shower before entering the pool (shower provided).
16. Violation of Pool Rules and/or Pool Gate Rules may result in loss of privileges to use the pool as well removal of your Pool Gate Code.
